News and information for all parents:

- Thanks to committee members and others who have helped out so far this year. Wet weather has stopped action on the field, but there has been a lot of work done to prepare for what we hope will be a successful season. We hope all parents will **volunteer to help** in some way during the year.
- Check out our **club website** www.urungafootball.com . It has heaps of information that you may need during the season, including contact details for committee members and coaches, and the draw for your team. Thanks to David Spears for managing the site.
- Our **Canteen** is a vital part of the Club's fundraising. Volunteers Helen Trist and Margaret Spears organise stock etc, but we need your help serving behind the counter on Saturday mornings. **Team managers need to arrange canteen helpers for each of your team's home games.** You will only need to do this once or twice if everyone does their share.
- **Club shorts, socks and T-shirts** are on sale at the canteen each Saturday. 2nd hand boots and uniforms are also available at the canteen. (Donations can be made on a Saturday morning)
- **Parents** from the first teams to play each Saturday on fields requiring nets are responsible for putting up **nets and corner posts**. *Managers must ensure this begins at least 45 minutes before kick-off, as referees will reduce match time if we are late to begin.* Parents from the **final** games must return this equipment. *All nets, posts etc are stored in the change room on the left as you enter at the male toilet door (not the green shed).*
- **Training gear**, such as ladders, poles etc are also kept in the change room to the left as you enter at the male toilet door. **Coaches** using this gear must return it at the end of each session.
- **Gear Reminders** – boots and shinpads must be worn at training; each child to bring their own drink bottle to training and the game; sunscreen and aerogard in the kitbag is not a bad idea.
- **Wet Weather** contact person is Andrew Jarrett (66556017, 0409 556017). Managers / Coaches can contact him if in doubt about OUR fields being open, and then pass information on to parents.
