- Most of our long serving committee members will be leaving the club this year and next. Next season we will need new volunteers to take up positions within the club if we are to remain strong. Positions that will be available for the Junior Sub-committee are:
President – oversees the running of the junior club.
Secretary – takes minutes at monthly committee meetings.
Treasurer – manages the Junior Club's finances.
Committee Member – attends meetings and assists with jobs as needed.
Registrar – coordinates the signing up process for players at the start of the season.
Publicity Officer – advertises Club events in the media.
Gear Steward – manages the Club's equipment and uniforms.
Ground Committee – maintain and mark fields.
Referee Coordinator – advertises referee training courses and allocate referees to non-competitive games.
Coaching Coordinator – advertises coaching courses.
Canteen Coordinator – ensures adequate stock and develops roster for canteen. (This may be a role for a group of 2/3 friends to consider taking on together to share the load)
