



## TAFE NSW Summer Football Competition Rules

### Rules – Juniors

- A minimum of 6 players and a maximum of 10 players per team
- Minimum age is 9yrs
- Maximum age is 14yrs (15yrs+ play in the Senior or Social Mixed 6-A-Side competition)
- Each nominated junior team must have a responsible adult manager that will be in attendance before the game starts and during the game
- Registration = \$50 per player.

### Rules – Seniors and Social/Mixed Teams

- A minimum of 6 players and a maximum of 10 players per team
- No more than 3 males 15yrs or over (or 4 males 14yrs or under) per team may take the field in social mixed teams
- To register in a senior team, you need to be minimum 15 years of age.
- Registration = \$700 per team.

### Rules - General

- In addition to the team nomination form, all players must individually register online via [www.urungafootball.com](http://www.urungafootball.com) or [www.playfootball.com.au](http://www.playfootball.com.au). You must be registered must be approved and paid in full before you take the field.
- All nominations forms must be returned before 11<sup>th</sup> October 2018
- Online registrations and fee payments must be submitted by 11<sup>th</sup> October 2018
- Players can only play in **one** nominated Junior or Senior team
- In addition, players aged 14+ can nominate into a Social Mixed team
- A minimum of 4 players from the registered team are required to field a team. If teams are short, they can borrow a maximum two players from another team to field 6 players
- All teams are required to have matching coloured shirts. Bibs will be available at Canteen if any teams clash
- Footwear must be worn. However, NO studded football boots are allowed
- Shin pads must be worn with long socks covering them
- No slide tackles
- 3 Points a win and 1 point a draw
- **If you are going to forfeit, please notify Michael McCormick on 0402 928 344 AND your opposing teams contact by 12pm on game day.** Contacts will be listed on the draw
- In the event of bad weather, notifications will be posted to the Urunga 6 A Side Soccer and Urunga Football Club Facebook page – by 2pm where possible
- We propose playing some wet weather catch up games if required on Tuesday nights
- Urunga Football Club reserves the right to deal with any persons or teams in respect of any offenses or complaints and other matters not specifically provided for in these rules
- The club may take media footage including photography for publicity purposes in newspapers, web page, Facebook etc. You must advise the club if you object.
